## Problem

Sync rules processors throw the [java.lang.Error](#), which causes the Exalate sync to stop.

### Error detail:

Error while processing requests

## Cause

This kind of error is usually caused by the custom groovy script in the Sync Rules as far as java.lang package and classes are imported by default in Groovy.

The following error classes are most commonly known as a cause of the synchronization and JIRA stop.
