

How to Stop Issue Sync in Jira Cloud

There are certain cases when you need to stop an issue synchronization at some point. The Exalate app has a built-in feature that helps to stop synchronizing an issue.

A typical use case is 'Move issue from one instance to another' which is actually the sequence:

1. Exalate Issue
2. Unexalate Issue
3. Delete local issue

There are multiple ways to stop issue synchronization:

- [Post-function](#)

Unexalate Button

You can use the **Unexalate operation** directly on an issue. [More details.](#)

Important: Make sure that all synchronization messages have been processed before using the Unexalate issue operation.

Post-function

JIRA includes several [post functions](#) that can be added to transitions. The Exalate app provides **Unexalate Now** post function. You can add it after a certain transition in the workflow on [Jira Cloud](#).

Note: You can also remove sync data by different criteria like an issue, a connection, or remove the whole synchronization info using a [clean-up tool](#).
