

# How to Sync Assignees on GitHub

This article shows how to synchronize assignees on GitHub.

## Introduction

GitHub supports multiple assignees in one field. When syncing from GitHub to Jira, Exalate takes the first assignee from the list and sends it to the Jira side.

## Source side(GitHub)

To send multiple assignees from GitHub use the code below:

### Outgoing sync

```
replica.assignees = issue.assignees
```

## Destination side(GitHub)

Add the code below to the **Incoming sync** if you want to add multiple assignees on the GitHub side.

```
issue.assignees = replica.assignees
```
