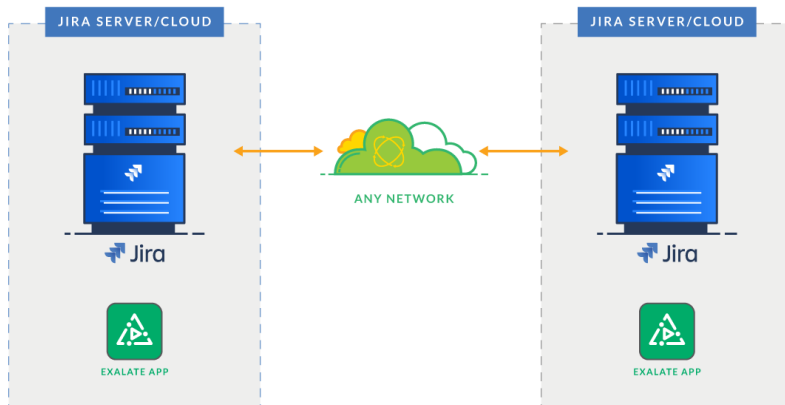


# Sync between Multiple Jira Cloud Instances

The **Exalate app for Jira Cloud** allows syncing issues bi-directionally or uni-directionally between Jira Cloud Instances.



## Configuration Steps:
