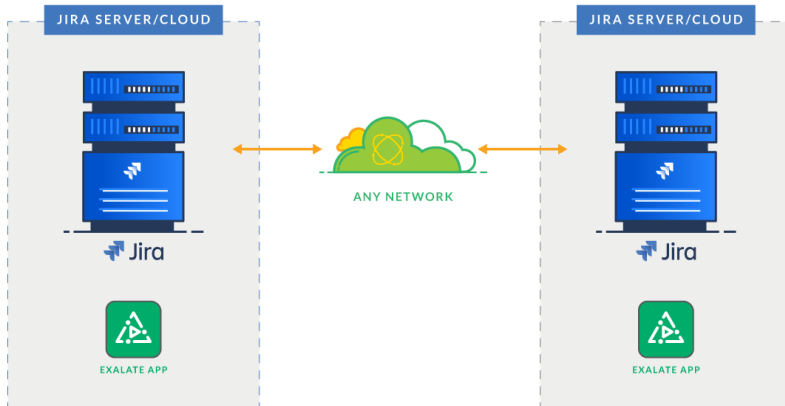


Sync between Multiple Jira Cloud Instances

One of the common use cases is synchronization between 2 Jira Cloud Instances.

The **Exalate app for Jira Cloud** allows syncing issues bi-directionally or uni-directionally between Jira Cloud Instances.



Configuration Steps:

1. Set up a Connection on your Instance

Note: Use the visual connection to set up the synchronization if you have admin access to both Jira cloud instances.

2. Make sure the Destination side has accepted the invitation
