    def qaUsers = userHelper.findInGroup("qa-team")
    issue.comments = commentHelper.addComment(
        "A blocker bug detected after the release! CC: ${ qaUsers.collect { "[~${it.username}]" }.join(", ") }.toString(),
        issue.comments
    )
}
```

Comments

You can use this method to get all the users in a group and use them in user-related operations. For example, mentioning QA users in a comment when there's a blocker bug detected.
