

# How to Find the Link to the Admin Console of Exalate for Salesforce

We host the Exalate app for Salesforce on Google Cloud. It means that the Exalate admin console has its own URL.

If you lost the URL of your Exalate app for Salesforce, you can recover it by following the steps below:

1. Copy the URL from the box below:

```
https://connect.exalate.net/rest/find?trackerurl=your_salesforce_instance_url
```

2. Replace *your\_salesforce\_instance\_url* with the link to your Salesforce instance.



Replacing *your\_salesforce\_instance\_url* should look like this:

```
https://connect.exalate.net/rest/find?trackerurl=https://idalko123-dev-ed.my.salesforce.com
```

**Important:** You must use the tracker URL from the Salesforce classic version, not from the Salesforce Lightning edition.

3. Copy and paste this URL in your browser search bar and press **Enter**
