

SyncRoom Limitations

As SyncRoom continues to evolve, the first release comes with some limitations to be aware of. These will be addressed in future updates to enhance functionality and flexibility.

Shared Access or Single Administrator

This version supports integrations managed by a **single administrator** or by **multiple admins who share access** to manage the integration collaboratively. Full support for independent multi-admin configurations is not available yet.

Versioning Scope

At this stage, versioning applies to a predefined context, which includes:

- **Two scripts** (one outgoing and one incoming).
- **Triggers** for the specified data flow.

Account Registration

Self-registration is not available in this release. To create a SyncRoom account, you need to request one.

Node Import Only

Existing nodes can be imported into SyncRoom, but creating or requesting a new node from within the interface is not supported.

Connection Import Only

You can manage existing connections by importing them into SyncRoom, but creating new connections directly within the interface is not possible at this time.
