How to Install Exalate for Freshservice

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Install and Configure Exalate for Freshservice on Exalate Cloud

This section describes how to request a Freshservice integration for Exalate.

Request an Evaluation Instance of Exalate for Freshservice

- 1. Go to the Exalate Integrations page: https://exalate.com/integrations/.
- 2. Select Freshservice.
- 3. Fill in a form with some basic information.

4. After submitting the form, you will be redirected to your new node in a separate tab. **Save the link to this node, as it serves as your permanent access point to the Exalate Freshservice node.**

5. Fill in and Save the General Settings fields by providing your Freshservice instance and the credentials of the Exalate proxy user.

Note: A proxy user is a Freshservice account that is responsible for accessing the information stored on your instance and applying any incoming changes.
