

# Install Exalate for Asana

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## How to Install Exalate for Asana

This article describes how to set up Exalate synchronization with your Asana workspace.

**Exalate for Asana:** Unlike traditional Asana apps, Exalate for Asana is a hosted service that connects to your workspace via API. Your data remains secure and is only accessed through Asana's official API.

## Before you begin

Ensure you have:

- Admin permissions in your Asana workspace
- Access to create Personal Access Tokens in Asana
- Your Workspace GID (we'll show you how to find this)
- An Exalate account

## Step 1: Find your Asana Workspace GID

The Workspace GID is a unique number that identifies your Asana workspace.

### From any Asana task URL

Open any task in your workspace and look at the URL:

- **V0 Format:** `https://app.asana.com/0/1208662487042272/1234567890123456`
- **V1 Format:** `https://app.asana.com/1/1208662487042272/project/1234567890123456`

The Workspace GID is the first long number after `/0/` or `/1/`

## Step 2: Create an Asana Personal Access Token

1. In Asana, click your profile picture in the top right
2. Select **Settings**
3. Go to the **Apps** tab
4. Click **Manage Developer Apps**
5. Click **Create New Personal Access Token**
6. Give it a name like "Exalate Integration"
7. Copy the token immediately

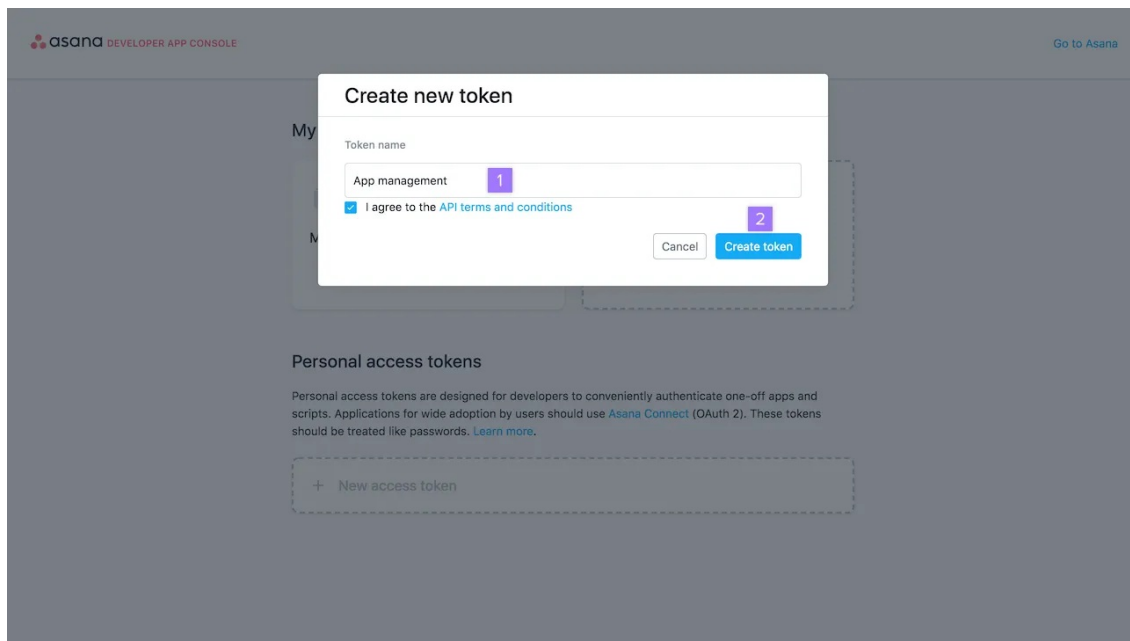
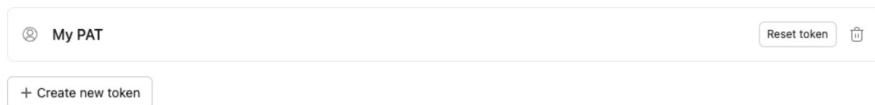
### My apps

Build on the Asana platform by creating apps. Apps can be just for your own team, or can be listed in the App Directory for others to use too.



### Personal access tokens

Personal access tokens allow developers to conveniently authenticate one-off apps and scripts. [Learn more](#)



**Security:** Treat your Personal Access Token like a password. Don't share it or store it in unsecured locations.

## Step 3: Register with Exalate

1. Go to the Exalate registration page
2. Select **Asana** as your platform
3. Enter your workspace information:
  - **Workspace URL:** `https://app.asana.com/0/YOUR_WORKSPACE_GID`
  - **Personal Access Token:** The token from Step 2
4. Complete the registration process

## Configure your General Settings

### \*Asana Url

Enter your Asana's URL where Exalate will be installed.

### \*Exalate Node Url

Copy & save this URL to access your Exalate admin console later.

### \*Password/API Token

Enter the password or API token for your proxy user account. [Learn More](#)

## Step 4: Test the connection

After registration, Exalate will test the connection to your workspace. You should see a success message confirming:

- Workspace access is working
- Token permissions are sufficient
- Basic task and project access is available
