What's included during the trial

During the trial, you have access to all connection types including basic, visual, and script-based configurations. You can use Aida for AI-assisted script generation, test versioning and rollback features, and explore the unified console interface. The trial works with all supported platforms including Jira Cloud, Jira Data Center, Azure DevOps, ServiceNow, Salesforce, Zendesk, GitHub, Freshdesk, and Freshservice.

You can extend the evaluation period beyond 30 days by contacting Exalate support if you need additional time to complete testing. For Jira on-premise evaluations, extensions are available directly through the Atlassian Marketplace following their standard policies.

What happens after the trial

After the trial ends, Exalate automatically transitions to a Free plan that allows up to 1,000 syncs per month with basic connections.
