Exalate Classic is compatible with various work management systems, enabling seamless synchronization across systems like Jira (Cloud & DC), Azure DevOps (Cloud & Server), ServiceNow, Zendesk, GitHub, Salesforce, Freshdesk, Freshservice, Asana, ServiceDesk Plus (ManageEngine), Ivanti, TopDesk, SolarWinds, ConnectWise, Xurrent, HaloITSM, and more.

To use Exalate Classic, you need a valid subscription for each node (system instance) you want to connect. This means that if you're synchronizing between two systems – for example, Jira and ServiceNow – you'll need a subscription for each.
