

How to Sync Time Tracking Fields in Jira On-premise

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To synchronize time tracking fields such as **Original estimate**, **Remaining estimate** or **Time spent** you need to add following scripts into the corresponding synchronization processors. Setting the time spent in Jira Cloud directly is not supported, it needs to be set through [worklogs](#).

Source Instance

Outgoing sync

Send *Time tracking* information to the Destination Instance.

```
// Add the time tracking information to the datafilter
replica.timeSpent      = issue.timeSpent
replica.originalEstimate = issue.originalEstimate
replica.remainingEstimate = issue.remainingEstimate
```

Destination Instance

Incoming sync

Apply received *Time tracking* information from the Source Instance.

```
// this will overwrite the current time tracking information

issue.timeSpent      = replica.timeSpent
issue.originalEstimate = replica.originalEstimate
issue.remainingEstimate = replica.remainingEstimate
```

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
